Welcome to the Bonner County Amateur Radio Club Net. This is Net Control Station [callsign, name]. This is a directed net and all stations are invited to check in.

This net meets every Tuesday evening except the 2nd Tuesday of the month which is our regularly scheduled monthly meeting.

Our net is at 6:00 pm or 1800 hours local time on a frequency of 145.490 with a minus offset and a 107.2 hertz tone. The purpose of the net is to provide information and training to our members throughout Bonner County.

In the event of an Emergency we will be using 145.600 Simplex.

{Pause letting repeater drop out}

All stations standby for check-in. Be advised that STATIONS WITH EMERGENCY TRAFFIC MAY BREAK IN AT ANY TIME. (pause) Visiting stations will be invited to check-in after the call for Bonner County Amateur Radio Club members.

{Pause letting repeater drop out}

This is Net Control Station [callsign]. Standby for Bonner County Amateur Radio Club member check-in. Check-in will be ordered alphabetically in groups by call sign suffix. When checking in, please inform Net Control if you have any traffic, contacts, or announcements, then hold for direction from Net Control. Any station needing to leave the net immediately after checking in, please advise Net Control and wait to be excused.

This is Net Control Station [callsign] now calling Bonner County Amateur Radio Club members with suffix (Alpha through Zulu).

{Pause and let the repeater drop; confirm check-ins (can confirm full call signs or suffix only, net control choice)}

Any more members with suffix (Alpha through Zulu)?

{Pause and let the repeater drop; confirm check-ins; repeat until no more members heard}

This is Net Control Station [callsign] now calling for any visiting stations. Please respond with your call, name and location.

{Pause and let the repeater drop; (can confirm full call signs or suffix only, net control choice)}

Any more visiting stations?

{Pause and let the repeater drop; confirm check-ins; repeat until no more visitors heard}

This is Net Control Station [callsign] with the following announcements for the net.

(Announcement #1) The club general meeting is held the second Tuesday of each month, 7:00 PM local time at the Bonner County Environmental Health office (part of Panhandle Health District) at 322 S. Marion Ave. just 1/2 block south of Highway 2 in Sandpoint, Idaho. Look for the parking lot on right side mid block.
